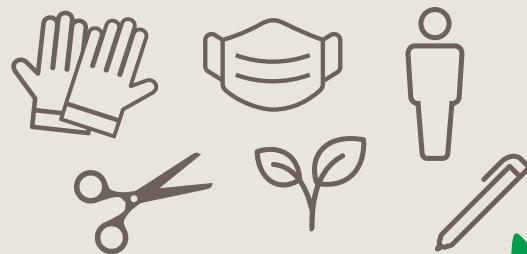
## READY TO GROW? FOLLOW THESE STEPS WITH THE HELP OF AN ADULT.

- 1 Before you start planting, choose a nice, sunny spot for your Mini Garden to grow.
- 2 Turn the bag over and poke drainage holes in the marked places.
- 3 Turn the bag back over and cut along the dotted lines marked on the front of the bag.
- 4 Fold the plastic flaps back under the bag to create a diamond shaped opening.
- 5 Scoop some mix out to make holes for your seedlings (save the mix you remove).
- 6 Gently take the plant from the current container, loosen the root ball and remove any loose or dead plant material or roots.
- 7 Plant your seedlings and fill back in with your saved mix, gently firming it around the base of the plant. The potting mix should be at the same level on the plant as it was previously.
- 8 Water well and watch your Mini Garden grow!
